Text: *Partial Differential Equations*, Second Edition, by Lawrence Evans. AMS GRADUATE STUDIES IN MATHEMATICS, Volume 19. (We may occasionally use other books which will be referenced at the relevant moment.)

Course contents: We will go over Evans' book Chapters 1 thru 3.2, 3.4 and some of Chapter 4, plus some extra material depending on time. We are aiming for covering all of the PDE Prelim Topics.

Course evaluation: There will be homework (30%), one midterm exam (30%), and a final (40%).

Homework: Homework that is assigned for grading should be written up clearly and in a mathematically rigorous way. You will be assigned a set of problems with a due date; since this is a very large class I will only grade a selected few of them, which will be collected at the due date. To streamline the process I ask you to bring the problems in separate sheets so you can turn in only the ones to be graded.
