The Yueh-er, Hong-hsu and Clarence Cheng Kuo Fellowship Endowment will be awarded this year during Honors Day, April 19, 2012. The Fellowship Endowment is open to all applicants regardless of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, disability, age, or veteran status with the following restrictions:

1. The Fellowship Endowment will be available to graduate students pursuing a Masters' degree in Mathematics who are currently enrolled or have been admitted to the University of Tennessee, Knoxville.
2. The Fellowship Endowment will recognize an outstanding Masters' student(s) specializing in any of the Masters' degree programs presented through the Department of Mathematics at the University of Tennessee. This includes a Masters' degree in pure or applied mathematics as well as the MM degree. Performance in course work at the Masters' degree level and recommendations from the faculty teaching those courses or involved with student's research will be the primary basis for the selection.
3. A student(s) who has held the Yueh-er, Hong-hsu and Clarence Cheng Kuo Fellowship Endowment is not eligible for the award in subsequent years.

This recipient will be selected by the Scholarship Committee from nominations received from the mathematics faculty.
