- What? The material will be from Chapter 1 (1.1-1.7). You should study Chapter 1, including the book, your lecture notes, recitation assignments and quizzes, and suggested problems. There is a nice list of concepts from the Chapter on page 57 of your text (the *Chapter Summary*). You should go through that list and make sure you are comfortable with problems using each of the concepts listed.
- How should I study? The absolute best way to study is by doing more problems. Once you have finished all the suggested problems, make sure you can do all the examples from class (lecture and recitation). (Write down just the problem, and then do it without looking at your notes. Understanding how someone else did a problem is much different from doing it yourself.) Make sure you know the terminology from the chapter. Do more problems. (There are many good problems at the end of the sections that were not assigned as suggested problems.)
