Course: Math 257, Honors Matrix Algebra I

Course description: The purpose of this course is to master matrix algebra and elementary linear algebra. We will cover systems of linear equations, Gaussian elimination, determinants, vector spaces, orthogonality, linear transformations, eigenvalues, and eigenvectors. Because this is an honors course, we will cover the computational aspects quickly in order to spend more time on further concepts.
